Cash Value Benefit (CVB) Update

The Cash Value Benefit (CVB) for Fruits and Vegetables has been higher than normal since 2021. However, the CVB amount is currently set to decrease for all states **September 30th, 2023**, due to the expiration of enhanced rates that were offered through the Families First Coronavirus Act.

Until further notice, starting on **October 1st, 2023**, the CVB values of all Louisiana food packages will change to:

- \$10/month for children
- \$12/month for pregnant, breastfeeding, and nonbreastfeeding postpartum women
- \$18/month for fully breastfeeding womenmultiples

There is a chance the CVB amounts will increase again. LA WIC is monitoring changes closely, and we will notify you and your families as soon as we know more information.
